## THE LADBROKE ASSOCIATION: GIFT AID DECLARATION

We are able to claim back tax on **all** your subscriptions and donations, if you are a qualifying UK tax payer, whatever the amount. All you have to do is to complete the declaration form below and return it to us. By signing this declaration, you are allowing The Ladbroke Association to reclaim the tax on any donations/subscriptions you make in the future, increasing the value of your gift by almost a third. Unlike a covenant, signing makes no commitment of future support, nor will there be any need for repeat signatures. To be a qualifying tax-payer, what you pay in income and capital gains tax must be at least equal to the amount that all the charities to which you donate can reclaim (i.e. the equivalent of a quarter of what you donate).
